SCHOOL CAR PARK

Would you please be aware that parents/carers are not permitted to bring their cars into the school car park at the beginning or end of the school day to drop off or collect children.

We would also request that parents/carers do not drop off their children or turn around at the school entrance from Perowne Way or at the pelican crossing. This is to protect the children as they walk near to the school entrance.

We would also ask parents/carers not park or turn around in the garage area adjacent to the school, or block driveways along Perowne Way, so that we do not annoy any of the local residents.

Parents/carers with disabled children are allowed to use the disabled parking bay in front of the school reception office as long as they get permission from the school.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter, ensuring that all children at Sandham keep safe during their journey to and from school.

Permits are also available from the school office for parent/carers to park their car in Sandown Station to drop their children off and collect them from school as part of the Travel Safe Plan.
